## Wednesday Prayer Meeting, 11/18/2020

### Opening Prayer

**Psalm: 140.7-13; Page 317**

**First Exhortation: The Warfare of the Christian: Ephesians 6.10-18; 2 Timothy 2.1-7**

**Pray for the officers and members of the Church, that they would do battle within and without.**

1. Pray for the people of God, that we all would see the great and pitched battle we are involved in, such that we would take up proper Spiritual defenses, not give arms to our enemies, not endanger our souls by loving this enemy land, and would train often with the Spiritual weaponry we have been given. (Ephesians 6.17)
2. Pray for the ministers of the Word, that they would lead the charge in the advance of the Kingdom of Christ, according to the commands of the Captain of our salvation, preaching the truth of the Word of God uncompromisingly, giving godly counsel and direction for the people of God, and mortifying the flesh. (2 Corinthians 10.3-4)
3. Pray that we would all do battle in our hearts, being careful not to give Satan a foothold there, but filling our hearts with Scripture, with godliness, and with the love of God, such that we would be spiritually fortified in the inner man. (Ephesians 3.14-21)
4. Pray that we would speak in the gates, in the places of commerce and business, and especially in our homes and to our children about the battle that rages all about us, speaking the truth in love to all, and helping one another unto protection, fortification, and vigilance against the enemy of our souls. (1 Peter 5.8-9)
5. Pray that the people of God would be courageous in following their Great Captain, not ashamed of His commands and counsels, seeking the truth and their marching orders according to truth from His mouth, ready in their places of service to advance His Kingdom in this world, bowed before Him, leaving all worldly courses. (Joshua 5.13-15)
6. Pray for the Church, that she would be mobilized behind her Victorious Captain, as He gives gifts to men, and leads His forces by His Word and Spirit. Pray that the ministers would teach the truth, the people would seek the truth and follow after the teachers the Lord has given. Pray also that false teachers, traitors to the King, would be rooted out of the kingdom of the Lord. (Psalm 21.7-13; Ephesians 4.1-16; 2 Corinthians 11.1-9)
7. As our Captain was made “perfect through sufferings” pray that the people of God would gladly bear His reproach, and suffer for His Name’s sake, if need be. (Philippians 1.29; Hebrews 13.12-14)

**Psalm: 144.1-8; Page 324**

**Second Exhortation: Christian Example and Exhortation: John 13.1-17; 1 Thessalonians 1.1-10**

**Pray that all in the Church would encourage one another to love and obedience by good example.**

1. Pray for the Church, that she would set a good example to the world in love, encouragement to that which is good, faith and obedience to Christ, repentance from sin, speaking the truth, and all other things. (Colossians 4.2-6)
2. Pray for the Church, that her officers and members would never discourage the hearts of one another in the faith, that we would live before the Lord together, striving together for the advancement of the Kingdom of the Lord, setting a good example of diligence and perseverance before one another. (Philippians 1.27-30)
3. Pray for the church, that she might set a godly example; of holiness in separating from that which is evil, of pursuing that which is good, of studying to know our duty, of preferring and honoring one another in love, of sacrificing for one another, leading each other in that which pleases the Lord. (1 Timothy 4.12)
4. Pray that we would never discourage one another’s heart away from obedience, but always toward it, that we would not suffer sin upon our brother or sister, but reprove it, that we would live before one another in such a way so as to gain credibility when such difficulty comes, that the body of Christ might be edified. (Deuteronomy 1.21-28)
5. Pray for ready hearts to follow the good examples we do have in history, and today, in faith, in perseverance, in truth and standing for the truth, in holiness and refusal of evil, and pray for humility that recognizes our need for such examples. (Hebrews 11.32-40)
6. Pray that the people of God would encourage one another by their mutual love, friendship, commitment to the truth, even in the face of suffering, affliction, and persecution. (Daniel 3.8-18)
7. Pray for a healing of division in the body through proper and loving confrontation regarding proper doctrine, godly practice and obedience, firm yet loving counsel and example, that they who are of the contrary part might be ashamed, and brought to acknowledge the truth. (Titus 2.1-10)
8. Pray that we all would fix our eyes upon Jesus and follow His example of sacrifice, speaking the truth, persevering in duty and obedience, and learn to set that example before one another. (Hebrews 12.1-3)
